BHS 131	Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation	1	The American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, and the American Safety and Health Institute provide training programs for certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation. All students are required to present documentation of current CPR certification at the time of entry into the specific health program. Specific programs accept selected certifications. Certification copy to be provided with the Advanced Standing Form.
BHS 138	Introduction to Medical Terminology (Medical Assisting only)	3	Completion of one year of Medical Terminology with an average grade of "B" or better.
BHS 139	Medical Terminology (Medical Assisting, Respiratory, Radiographic Imaging, Physical Therapy Assistant, Occupational Therapy Assistant, EMS)	3	Completion of one year of Medical Terminology with an average grade of "B" or better.
CPT 104	PC Microcomputer Lab	2	Completion of one-half year of microcomputer operating systems (Windows), Word and Excel with a grade of "B" or better, 90% attendance, and recommendation from student's instructor.
